CAMPSITE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Conditions of admission and other formalities :

You must have the permission of the owner to enter, set-up and stay on a campsite. Staying on the campsite implicates that you accept and will abide by these rules and regulations.

Any person wishing to stay on site for at least one night must show their passport, fill out the necessary forms and pay any money due. Unaccompanied children can only enter with written authorisation of their parents.

2. Setting-Up :

Tents, caravans or camping cars and their equipment should be set-up in the place allocated by the owner and according to the owners' instructions.

Caravans longer than 6 metres in length, double axel caravans, lorries, wagons and trailers are not allowed onto the campsite.

Camping space conditions : 1 caravan or 1 camping car or 1 tent + 1 tent maximum for a total of 5 people.

3. Reception :

The reception is open from : variable according to season.

4. Payments :

Payments should be made at the reception. The amount will be according to the tariffs shown at the entrance to the campsite. Payment is due according to the number of people and the number of nights spent on the campsite.

Campers should make departure known to the owner the day before leaving.

Campers wishing to leave before the official opening time must pay any due fees the day before leaving (if payment was not made upon arrival).

5. Noise and Silence :

Campers are asked not to make any noise or discussion that may disturb their neighbours. Closing of doors and boots should be done as discreetly as possible.

There must be no noise whatsoever between 10pm and 7.30am. The owner reserves the right to modify these times when putting on evening entertainment.

6. Animals (2 maximum per camping place) :

Animals should be vaccinated and kept on a lead. Category 1 & 2 dogs (pitbull, rottweiler...) are not allowed. Dogs and other animals should never be left to run freely and shouldn't be left alone on the campsite, as it they are the owners civil responsibility and shouldn't be allowed to disturb others. Do not give food to wild animals on the campsite.

7. Visitors :

Visitors are allowed on the campsite with permission of the owner and are the invitees responsibility. Campers can meet visitors at the reception. If visitors wish to enter the campsite or use the on-site services, the invitee must pay the entrance fee which is indicated at the entrance of the campsite. Visitors cars are forbidden onto the campsite.

8. Traffic and parking conditions :

Vehicles must drive slowly whilst on the campsite. No driving is allowed from 10pm to 7.30am.

Only campers vehicles are allowed onto the campsite. Parking is forbidden in places where tents are normally set-up and vehicles must not disrupt other traffic or get in the way of new arrivals setting-up.

9. Behaviour and aspect of the installations :

Everyone one must respect the cleanliness of the campsite and avoid anything that may degrade the hygiene of the campsite and it's buildings. It is forbidden to throw used water on the ground or into ditches. Caravaners must empty their used water in the places set-up for this purpose. Food waste and all rubbish must be put in bins. Recycling containers can be found at the entrance to the campsite.

Washing is forbidden outside of the washrooms and laundry must be dried in the shared drying area. Campers are asked to respect each other tent site (e.g.: not use other peoples sites as a short cut). Any damage done to plants, grounds or buildings within the campsite will have to be paid for. The tent site used during your stay should be maintained and left in the same state as when you arrived.

10. Security :

Fire : open fires (wood, coal, barbecue etc.) are forbidden (prefectoral decree). All cookers should be kept in good working condition and not used in dangerous conditions. In the case of fire, immediately contact the management. Extinguishers can be used if necessary, they can be found in both washrooms, the maintenance room (near the barbecue) and in the building at the entrance to the campsite.

A first aid kit can be found at the swimming pool first aid post.

The cigarettes and cigarette ends must not be thrown to the ground, they must be completely put out then thrown to the dustbin.

Theft : the camper is responsible for his/her own tent-site and must notify the management when suspicious of potential thieves.

The campsite refuses all responsibility in the case of loss or theft.

11. Games :

No games that disturb others are allowed near tent sites.

The games room is available for all such games.

Children must always be look after by their parents.

Borrowed books and board games should returned in their original state and with all pieces included.

12. Swimming Pool :

Swimming shorts are forbidden, swimming trunks are obligatory (according to national law requirements), it is forbidden to drink, eat or smoke near the pool. Large inflatable objects are forbidden. It is forbidden to walk in shoes near the pool. Full pool regulations can be found near the pool.

13. 'Garage mort' :

No object or material can be left on the campsite unless authorised by the management and in the place of their choosing. A payment must be made for the 'garage mort'. Beware : the 'garage mort' is not a security service. The campsite is not responsible for any problem or incident occurring during this time.

14. Notice :

These rules and regulations can be seen at the entrance to the campsite. Copies can be provided for campers upon demand.

15. Breaking the rules and regulations :

Any camper who disturbs others or who does not respect the local rules and regulations will be warned orally or in written form by the owner to stop the disturbance. In serious or repeated cases and having already been warned, the owner can annul the contract. In the case of illegal behaviour the owner will contact the police.

16. Web Site and leaflet:

Texts, photos, plans are not contractual elements.

17. In the event of litigation, only the Court of Privas is qualified.
